#### **VIEW POINT HEALTH**

We are a Community Service Board which provides services as the safety net for Mental Health, Substance Use, and Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities serving Gwinnett, Rockdale and Newton Counties. We serve uninsured individuals, Medicaid, or Medicare



We serve adults, youth, and children through outpatient individual and group counseling, community based services, school-based counseling and youth wraparound care. In addition, we provide residential services, day programs, supported employment, court and re-entry services.

#### **SUBSTANCE USE SERVICES**

We provide individual and group outpatient counseling. In addition, we provide residential services, youth clubhouses, inpatient recovery, Medically Assisted Treatment, and inpatient detox.

#### **INTELLECTUAL & DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITES**

We serve adults through day programs, supported employment, and residential services.

#### **CRISIS SERVICES**

We have three 24 hour Crisis Stabilization units:

Adults (Lawrenceville) Child & Adolescent (Decatur) Adolescent Autism (Conyers)









#### **Who We Serve**








